

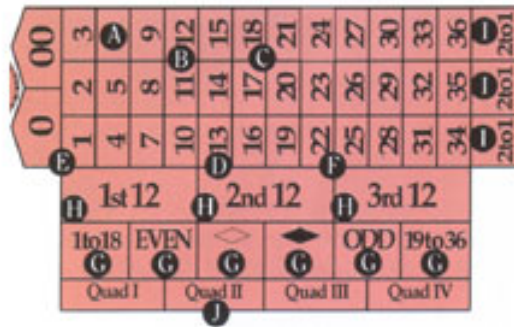
# Roulette



Roulette, the American version of one of the oldest and most popular European gambling games, is easy and fun to play.

You place a bet with casino chips or special colored Roulette chips. If you wish to buy Roulette chips, the dealer will give you your own colored chips so he will always know which bets are yours. How much you buy in for determines the value of each chip. These special colored chips must be redeemed at the Roulette wheel before you leave.

You place your bets, and the dealer spins the ball. If it lands where you placed your chip, you win!



How many numbers your chip has covered determines the payoff odds.

## BETTING ODDS

<b>A</b>	35-to-1	<b>STRAIGHT UP</b> - Any number, 0, and 00.
<b>B</b>	17-to-1	<b>SPLIT</b> - In this case, ii and 12 pay.
<b>C</b>	8-to-1	<b>CORNER</b> - In this case, 17, 18, 20 and 21 pay.
<b>D</b>	11-to-1	In this case, 13, 14 and 15 pay.
<b>E</b>	6-to-1	0, 00, i, 2 and 3 pay.
<b>F</b>	5-to-1	Here 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 pay.
<b>G</b>		<b>EVEN MONEY</b>
<b>H</b>	2-to-1	<b>1ST DOZEN</b> - Pays on any number 1 through 12. Same for second or third dozen.
<b>I</b>	2-to-1	<b>COLUMN BET</b> - Pays on any number in that horizontal column.
<b>J</b>	3-to-1	<b>QUAD COLORS BETS</b>
